## Page Field Airport Security -by Sherrie Lorenz

At last month's General Member meeting, we were privileged to have a visit from Lt. Thomas Payne, from the Lee County Port Authority Police Department speak to our group about airport security at Page. He related a few stories and also reviewed the responsibilities that anyone coming or going from the airport property should know and be practicing. So here's a little review...

When entering or exiting any of the coded gates in your car, only one vehicle at a time should go through the gate, and stop on the other side and watch until the gate closes, making certain nobody scoots through the gate that should not be there. If you see any suspicious activity around the airport property, call the airport police office at (239) 590-4810. The number is also posted right on the gates. We who are based at Page are the best eyes and ears around. We know our hangar mates and know who parks their airplanes on what ramp, and which cars belong to whom. So we have a pretty good idea who belongs where. If anything ever seems out of order, just call and have it checked out.



Never give the gate code numbers out to guests who are coming to meet you at the airport. Having a non-pilot driving a car around the airfield is inviting disaster. Not just from a security standpoint, but also the risk of runway incursions, which have happened here at Page. It makes for a bad day for everyone involved to have someone unfamiliar with an airport to end up wandering down the centerline of runway 5 in their car, being chased by lights and sirens. You can pretty much bet that your flight plans are going to be delayed. Have guests meet you at the Aviation Center and park their car there. Then you can pick them up and drive to your hangar. Everybody stays safe and happy.

So here's a question: What if you drive up to a gate, punch in your code, and are patiently waiting for the gate to roll open, and a rudely impatient driver rushes up behind you, maybe starts honking the horn wanting you to get moving? You do not need to get out and confront the individual, pull over and let them pass, but get their car make and license number and call airport police. If you don't have the direct number, you can always call 911 and the call will get routed to them.



In this day and age, it is a privilege to have the level of access that we enjoy to an airport facility. But we need to make sure that the privilege is not abused. Security is everybody's responsibility. We all need to be diligent and alert around the airfield. Be observant. Keep your eyes and ears open and if something does not look or feel right, let the authorities know about it. Page Field is a safe and fun place to fly from, let's all keep working together to keep it that way!
