## Board Meeting Minutes – Synopsis, October, 2009

The board of directors met on October 21, 2009 at 6:30 PM. Below is a synopsis of the business discussed at that meeting:

Kirchner reported hours flown still down this month. Member count was 85 active, 11 active students, 40 inactive and 8 officer members. The profit and loss and balance sheets were reviewed. Graham states costs are down 1.9% and revenue is down 23% for the first 10 months of this year when compared to last. Hall reports he has no applicants to present at this time. The Timetrac printer is not working. S. Lorenz will assist with finding a replacement parallel port printer. Action for Page Field Day discussed. Hall to bring literature and will be at field by 9 AM. Pritchard has list of 2 shifts of workers, and will bring can coolies to give away. He requests volunteers wear their club shirts. The volunteers will set up the cabana. Voorhees will bring donuts, and "boarding by invitation only" signs. Carroll reported upcoming maintenance items are a mixture control cable for 21Q, strobe wiring for 4CC, and wheel fairing for 90X. Kirchner and Voorhees have put strips on the pavement in front of each hangar to help guide planes into the hangars. Pritchard reported BBQ was poorly attended, and possible reasons were discussed. Christmas Party is planned for Dec 16, Pritchard will organize and present budget plan for approval. Kidder presented issue of turning off individual electronics vs. the avionics Master Switch, which is recommended by the Club. And members are still touching GPS screen in 21Q. Spare GPS card for 90X is missing. Ledet will present 30 min training sessions for KLN94 beginning at Jan General Meeting.

Angel Flight request was discussed and approved. Guest Mr. Grady inquired about Club interest in purchasing LSA aircraft. Possible in future, not feasible at this time. Three Board vacancies to be filled at the December elections: Kidder, S. Lorenz and Ledet. McRae and Herr to recruit for slate of candidates.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50pm. The next board meeting will be held on November 18, 2009 at 6:30PM. Any club member having concerns or questions about club operations should contact any board member.
