Board Meeting Minutes

— Synopsis, December, 2009

The officers and board of directors met on December 9, 2009 at 6:35 PM in conference room at the Page Field Aviation Center.. Below is a synopsis of the business discussed at that meeting:

Kirchner reported that hours flown have increased to 109.5 this month, but the P&L statement shows a \$4800 loss. Hall reports that one new membership applicant from Page Field Day has dropped out, but several new applicants were voted into the club at the last general meeting. No new maintenance problems have been reported. Investigation of the tail strike incident on N3521Q has narrowed to 5 or 6 members, but no one has come forward to admit responsibility. This issue will be addressed at the general meeting. Pritchard announced the Christmas Party will be held on December 16. Music, food and drinks will be provided. Group flyout options for a February club activity were discussed. The Sunshine Derby Race will be held on January 23 in Labelle and members are approved to fly in this event. Pilot Experience Forms (AIG Insurance Form): according to the club's insurance broker, each club pilot must complete an AIG form with current information. Pilots not supplying this information will not be able to fly club aircraft, and will be removed from Schedulmaster. Newly elected board members Eric Graham, Marc Scappaticcio, and Jim Meyersburg were seated.. The following state of officers was elected for 2010: President-Terry Voorhees, Vice President-Kent McRae, Secretary-Ellen Herr, Treasurer-Larry Kirchner, Membership Director-Steve Hall, Activities Director-Doug Pritchard, Discipline Officer-Chris Kidder, Safety Officer-Marc Scappaticcio, Newsletter Publisher-Sherrie Lorenz, Legal Officer-Bob Adamski. The following trustees were elected for the aircraft acquisition trust: Adamski (beneficiaries), Kidder (general member), and McRae (board representative).

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55pm

THIS MONTH'S QUESTION AND ANSWER:

Member: "Hey, Cubby, I want to share a flight with another Club member. How do I enter that into schedulemaster after the flight?"

CUBBY: "Good Question! First off, both of you need to fill out the in-plane log sheet with the Hobbs time that each of you flew. Then the person who made the reservation in schedulemaster should enter the Tach time for the ENTIRE flight, and then enter their individual Hobbs time. Then click on "Bill Additional User" and enter the name and Hobbs time of the other pilot. That's it! Sharing a flight is a great way to get some fun airtime and stick to a budget, and it keeps our Club planes flying. Thanks for asking!"

THIS IS A REMINDER: When landing Club Cub Aircraft, it is required that they are landed according to POH speeds. The rate at which we are replacing tires and the wear evidence on the replaced tires, indicates this is not being done. Also the side wear is an indication that people are trying to exit the runway at excessive speeds. You own the runway until you clear it.

All pilots are asked to please fly accordingly. These are your planes, please take care of them.
