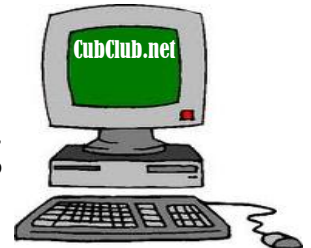

Board Meeting Minutes — Synopsis, February, 2010 by Ellen Herr

The officers and board of directors met on February 17, 2010 at 6:40 PM in conference room at the Page Field Aviation Center. Below is a synopsis of the business discussed at that meeting:

Kirchner reported that the operating loan and part of the sinking fund have been paid off, reducing the amount of interest expense. The board voted to discontinue the Skylane 182 discount rate program for training effective April 1st.

The Poker Run will be held on March 13, with a preflight contest held in addition to the picnic and poker hands. Doug Pritchard has resigned as activities chair, due to other commitments. Jim Meyersburg has agreed to take over this position. The board thanks Doug for his service.

The board continued to discuss the recommendations of the Financial Planning Committee. Options for reducing hangar rental costs, and increasing utilization of N9490X were discussed. Meyersburg suggested the club be featured on a segment of the Fox 4 morning show to increase membership. Scappaticcio will be in charge of the training seminar schedule for the coming year. Suggested topics to be covered included GPS and autopilot usage, preflight planning, etc.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:17 pm

CUBBY'S CORNER

Member's Forum



Got a question about the Cub Club? ASK CUBBY!

THIS MONTH'S QUESTION AND ANSWER:

Member: *"Hey, Cubby, I want to take a Club plane to the Bahamas for a week. What costs will I incur for Ground Time?"*

CUBBY: *"Great Question! On flights over 72 hours, the aircraft must be flown an average of 2.5 hours per day. If the aircraft is not flown an average of 2.5 hours per day, the difference between the actual flight time and the required time will be charged as "Ground Time" to the member, at 1/3 of the hourly rate of that aircraft... Here's an example using our Cessna Skyhawk:*

7 day trip = 17.5	Hours of Total Required Flight Time
11.5	Actual Time Flown During Trip
=====	
6.0	Hours Difference
x \$21.67	1/3 Rental Rate of Skyhawk
=====	
= \$130.02	

The member would be charged an additional \$130.02 for Ground Time for this flight. I hope this helps clarify that... Thanks for asking!"
